


# Daylight graph

## Daylight graph


A **pictogram** is a way of showing information using pictures. We use the pictures to count instead of writing numbers.

Create a pictogram of the number of hours of daylight on day in the middle of each season. You can use the information in the table below, or research your location using the Internet, or keep a record of the number of hours of daylight throughout the year. You can cut and stick the pictures provided, or draw your own.



Table showing the number of hours of daylight on days in the middle of each season

Spring	11
Summer	16
Autumn	11
Winter	7

What happens to the number of hours of daylight between Spring and Summer?

What happens to the number of hours of daylight between Winter and Spring?
